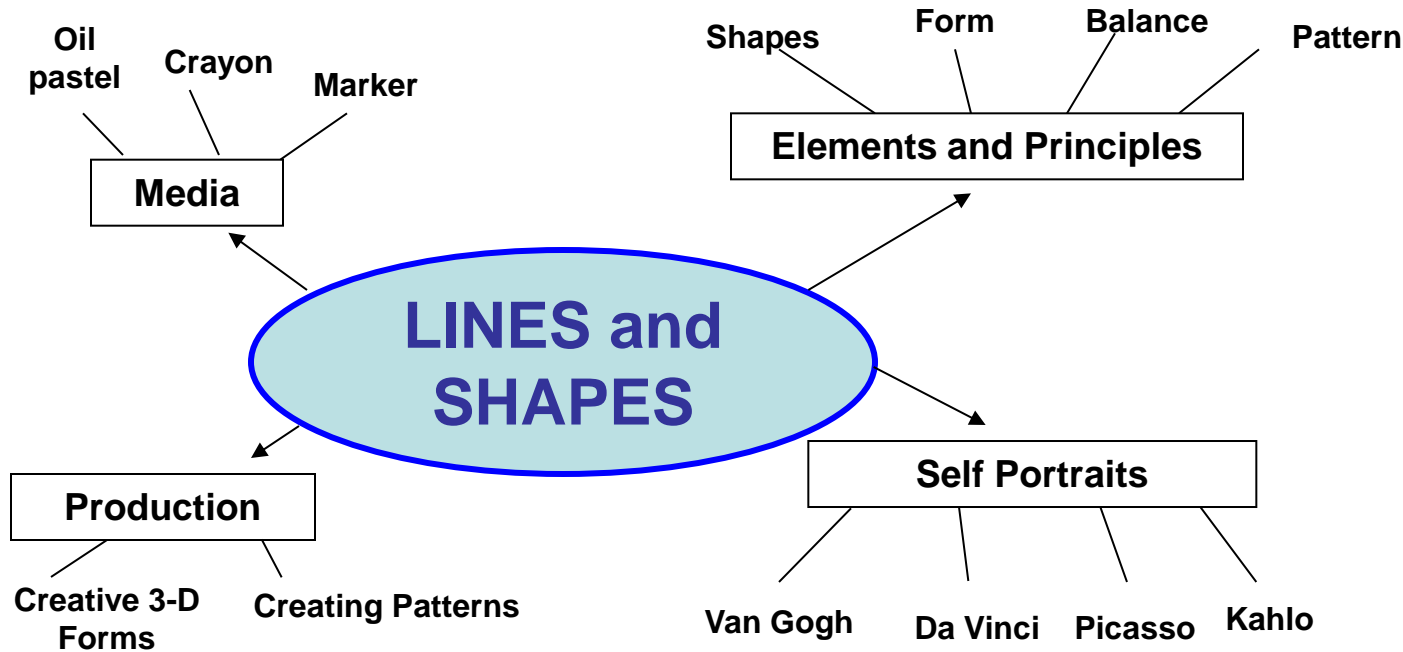

Essential Understandings/Questions:

- A line is a distance from one point to another point.
- A shape is a line that closes off a space.
- Bumpy, wavy, zig-zag lines can create movement.
- A form is a three dimensional shape.
- 2-D has two dimensions—height and width.
- 3D has three dimensions—height, width and depth.
- Line can create emphasis by radiating from a shape, by repeating a contour.
